ON ENTERING THE RANGE IT IS MANDATORY TO COMPLETE THE RANGE REGISTER

1. Competitors must be affiliated with the relevant State Association.
2. ISSF, TRA, RBA & MRPC Rules apply.
3. Graded Prizes will depend on Nominations at the Club's discretion. Grades C&D may be combined if insufficient nominations.
4. All Gradings in accordance with the latest State Gradings List. If not graded please produce your last 3 scores otherwise you will be graded as A grade.
5. Firearms must be locked away securely when not in use, Bolts removed and breech flags in place. Bolts are to be open and back with a breech flag inserted and magazines removed at all times except when you are in the firing position.
6. Weapons Licence to be produced to the Nomination Officer on entering the Range.
7. The Programme may be altered at any time at the Club's discretion. Any changes will be advised if possible.
8. Protests are to be lodged within 10 minutes of the final scores being posted with a fee of \$2.00.
